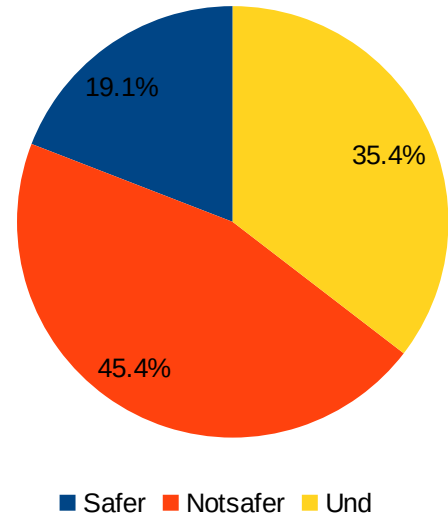
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Q5. Crime is on the rise in New Orleans. Do you feel safer now than before Mayor Cantrell took office?

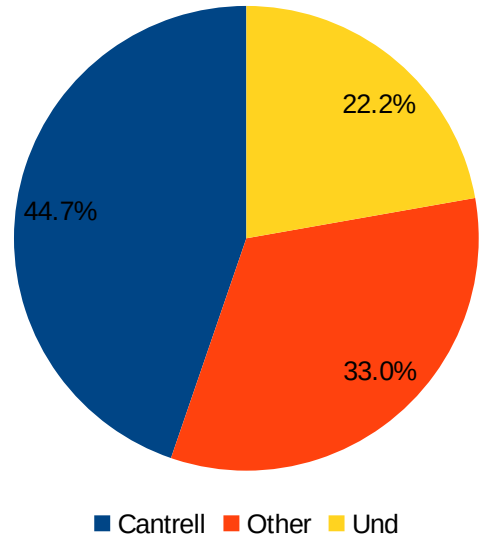

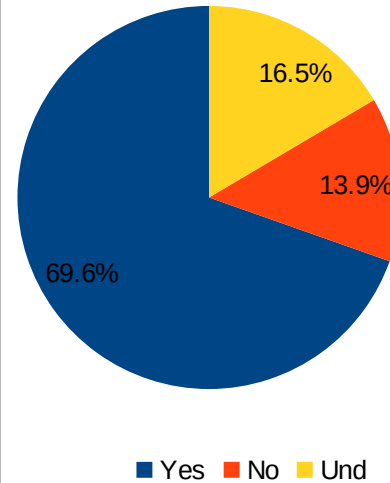
